On November 7, 1986, the Wisconsin Chapter of the IAAI established a scholarship program. No more than two scholarships will be awarded each year. Each scholarship will be worth \$750.00. Guidelines for applying are outlined below.

1. The number of scholarships to be given will be determined by the Scholarship Committee with the approval of the Board of Directors.
2. To be eligible, applicants must be recommended by a member of the Wisconsin Chapter of the IAAI.
3. Applicants must be enrolled or planning to enroll in the next scheduled semester of a two or four year technical school, college or university that offers courses in police or fire sciences including fire investigation and related subjects.
4. Applications must be **received or post marked not later than March 31** each year for fall semester consideration. Applications **received after March 31, will not be considered.**
5. Letter of Interest from applicant must include a biography of themselves to include: What you have done, what you are involved in, and what do you plan to do in this profession.
